NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Thompson:

This letter confirms my visit on October 19, 2011 to your property at 4435 Sugar Grove Road, Lancaster wherein I advised you that you had been open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code 3745-19-04(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, you have been open burning landscape waste within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off your premises.

We are also noting that we sent you a warning letter dated November 5, 2009 for a similar incident. You stated you did not receive that letter.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
