NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Ms. Rauch:

This letter confirms our conversation of November 9, 2011 wherein I advised you that you have been open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-19. These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, at 3757 Fre Mar Road, Lancaster, Ohio, you have been open burning landscape waste within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off your premises. Be aware that it is also a violation of OAC 3745-19 to transport material from one location to another location and burning it for the purpose of waste disposal.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
