**NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Ms. Elliot:

This letter confirms a visit to your property at about 244 State Street, Brinkhaven, Ohio by the Eastern Knox County Joint Fire District, wherein they observed that you have been open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code(OAC) 3745-19. These actions are subject to fines and penalties. As one of the property owners, you share the ultimate responsibility of any violations.

Specifically, on August 2, 2007, you were open burning landscape waste and a small stump, and this open burning was occurring within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises. Additionally, at least some of this landscape waste is believed to be generated offsite.

We are also noting that we sent your son, Richard Elliot, a Certified Notice of Violation November 1, 2006 for a similar violation at 17006 Dodd Road.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
