Thank you and your contractor, Lawhon and Associates, for your written responses to Ohio EPA's January 29, 2007, Notice of Violation letter which were received on January 25, 2008; January 15, 2008; December 11, 2007; and September 14, 2007. Other follow-up correspondence on these matters outlining the needs and possible approaches to be taken for compliance were also sent to you in a letter dated May 24, 2007, and emails on June 29, 2007, September 17, 2007, and December 10, 2007.

The documentation you submitted included a report detailing the removal of approximately 8,000 waste fluorescent lamp tubes (including about 6,000 lbs. of broken bulbs) and the decontamination of a concrete pad and a nearby sump by the area in which a roll-off box container holding these waste items was held from approximately September 2006 to September 7, 2007.

The submittal included Universal Waste Bills of Lading (#43371 and #043383) for the shipment of 2430 intact 4-foot lamp tubes and of 8,000 lbs. of broken waste lamps on September 7 and 11, 2007 to a recycler, USA Lamp and Ballast in Cincinnati, OH -- confirming the material was properly received and was in fact recycled as Universal Waste.

My review of this documentation reveals that the Ohio Jobs and Family Services Department has now abated all violations discovered during the January 23 and 24, 2007 inspection as listed below.
