I have received your October 18, 2011 letter which responded to my September 21, 2011 inspection of Donnell Ford located at 152 Continental Drive, Salem, Ohio. As outlined below you have documented a correction of all the violations found during that inspection.

1. **OAC Rule 3745-52-11 – Hazardous waste determination.**
Your letter states the fluorescent lamps will now be saved to be sent to a lamp recycler. It also states that the waste in the drums I saw will be picked up by Environmental Specialties. You have determined that this waste is not a hazardous waste. These documents document your correction of this violation.
2. **OAC Rule 3745-273-13 (D)(2) - Universal waste lamp containers.**
This was previously corrected.
3. **OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C) - Used oil labels.**
Your letter documents the correction of this violation.
