Dear Mr. Conley:

Thank you for assisting George Strobel and me during the complaint investigation on October 18, 2011. The complaint alleged TNT Powerwash was storing buckets of grease behind the building and that grease was all over the ground. During the investigation, we observed empty 55 gallon drums behind the building that had grease on top. We did also observe one area where grease had been wiped on a metal pole and was on the ground around the pole. It appears that workers are using sticks to get grease off the trucks before washing, then wiping the sticks either on the drum lids or onto the pole to get the grease off the sticks. The grease on the drum lids, pole and ground need to be cleaned up. The employees need to find an alternative method for cleaning the grease off the sticks.

During the investigation we observed a used oil drum that was not properly labeled. According to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-279-22(C)(1): Containers and aboveground tanks used to store used oil at generator facilities must be labeled or marked clearly with the words "Used Oil." **Therefore, TNT Powerwash is in violation of OAC 3745-279-22(C)(1).**

You properly labeled the used oil drum while we were still on-site. **TNT Powerwash is no longer in violation of OAC 3745-279-22(C)(1).**
