Dear Mr. Hastings:

On June 1, 2010, I returned to Hastings Body Shop (facility) at Road 8P in Columbus Grove, Putnam County, and met with you. I was able to verify that you had distilled the remaining waste paint related solvent and transferred the used oil in two 5-gallon pails and one 250-gallon tank into the tank inside the shop (which is labeled with the words "Used Oil"). You stated that you would not be operating any kind of business at the facility.

Therefore, Hastings Body Shop abated the violations of ORC Section 3734.02(E) & (F), OAC Rule 3745-51-03(G)(3), 3745-52-11, 3745-279-22(C)(1), 3745-279-23, 3745-279-24 and 3745-279-22(A)(B) & (D) on June 1, 2010. All the violations observed during Ohio EPA's July 8, 2004, inspection and first cited in Ohio EPA's July 21, 2004, Notice of Violation letter have been abated. No further injunctive relief will be required for this site. This case is closed.
