On August 23, 2011, I visited your facility to determine your progress in abating the violation I discovered during my July 13, 2010, inspection of Shelby Quick Lube. The violation I discovered was communicated to you in a July 28, 2010, Notice of Violation letter. On August 23, 2011, you indicated that you had contacted several of the fluorescent lamp recyclers I provided to you during the July 13, 2010, inspection and you agreed to recycle the fluorescent lamps generated from lighting your facility when they become spent. You also indicated that you had not generated any spent fluorescent lamps since my July 13, 2010, inspection.

Based on your oral communications with me, Shelby Quick Lube has abated the violation discovered during the July 13, 2010, inspection as listed below.
