Notice of Violation- Failure to properly submit 4th Quarter Post-Closure Care
Inspection report

Dear Mr. Danis:

On January 17, 2012, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Southwest District Office (SWDO), received the document titled Tremont Sanitary Landfill 4th Quarter Post Closure Inspection Report, dated January 13, 2012 (Report) for the Closed Tremont Landfill (Facility) located in Clark County. The Report was prepared and submitted by Civil and Environmental Consultants, Inc. on behalf of the Tremont Landfill Company.

Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-14(A)(4) states in part:

“Quarterly inspection of a sanitary landfill facility during each year of the post-closure care period and submittal of a written summary to the appropriate Ohio EPA district office not later than fifteen days after the inspection date detailing the results of the inspection and a schedule of any actions to be taken to maintain compliance ...”

By your admission the Quarterly Post-Closure Landfill inspection occurred on December 28, 2011, therefore the inspection report was required to be submitted to Ohio EPA, SWDO by January 12, 2012. Since Ohio EPA, SWDO received the Report on January 17, 2012, Tremont Landfill Company, as the owner, operator, failed to submit the Report within the required timeframe and therefore is in **violation** of OAC Rule 3745-27-14(A)(4).

Compliance with the requirements outlined in this letter shall not relieve you of your obligation to comply with other legal obligations, including, but not limited to, Chapter
