On November 2, 2011, I received a letter from you regarding the clean-up of Peg Bathalter's property near the corner of Hide-a-Way Hills Road and Klump Road in Hocking County. The submittal contained copies of receipts from M & B Demolition Disposal on Sugar Grove Road in Lancaster. The receipts indicated that six loads of demolition debris were disposed of at the facility on October 25 and 26.
