Dear Mr. Cole:

Thank you for your letters dated November 30, 2011 and December 6, 2011 and your December 13, 2011 e-mail, responding to Ohio EPA's November 21, 2011 Notice of Violation letter. You submitted documentation including: an updated contingency plan, inspection logs, and a land disposal restriction form.

My review of this documentation reveals that Mahle has adequately demonstrated abatement of all violations discovered during the September 13, 2011 inspection.

In letters dated September 27, 2011 and November 21, 2011, Ohio EPA had cited Mahle in violation of OAC Rule 3745-270-07(A)(7). As discussed with you in our December 6, 2011 conference call, after further rule review Ohio EPA determined that Mahle could choose to comply with either the requirements of OAC Rule 3745-270-07(A)(7) or the requirements of OAC Rule 3745-270-07(A)(2) for the D008 wastewater waste stream. Mahle has provided documentation that they are complying with OAC Rule 3745-270-07(A)(2); therefore, Ohio EPA is retracting the original citation of OAC Rule 3745-270-07(A)(7).
