Dear Sir or Madam:

On November 18, 2011, Ohio EPA attempted to conduct a complaint investigation of Kelcor Enterprises at 525 Eighth Street, Marietta, in response to a complaint received by this office alleging that containers of an unknown substance were stored at this address. During my attempted investigation, I observed approximately 40 5-gallon containers labeled "U-47 Bond-Coat" stored next to a fence alongside the house at the above address. Some of the containers were open. Most contained a mixture of a solid and liquid. No one was home at the time so I was unable to speak with anyone at the residence. I also attempted to conduct an inspection of Kelcor Enterprises located at 13191 Waterford Road, Waterford on November 18 and 23, 2011. No one was present either time so I was unable to speak with any facility representatives or residents of the home located at this address.

Based on my limited investigation, I found the following violations of Ohio's hazardous waste laws. In order to correct these violations, you must do the following and send me the required information ***within 21 days*** of the date of this letter:

- (1) OAC Rule 3745-52-11, Hazardous Waste Determination:** Any person who generates a waste must evaluate it to determine if it is a hazardous waste in accordance with the criteria set forth in OAC Chapter 3745-51.

Kelcor Enterprises has failed to determine if the contents of the above-described containers at 525 Eighth Street in Marietta are a hazardous waste. In order to abate this violation, Kelcor must immediately evaluate the contents using MSDS information or chemical analysis for TCLP, and submit the results of the evaluation to me, as well as a description of how and where this waste was generated. Should the contents be hazardous, they must be disposed of as such in accordance with Ohio law. Based on the information that you send me, I will provide you with information on the proper disposal of this waste.

## GENERAL COMMENTS

- (a) On November 23, 2011, I observed a large volume of what appeared to be a mixture of household and commercial waste in a large burn pit next to the steel building at 13191 Waterford Road. The pit contained ashes from previous burns. Note that burning of solid and/or hazardous waste is prohibited. This issue has been referred to the Ohio EPA Division of Air Pollution Control for follow up.
- (b) Please describe the type of business or industry that you operate from 13191 Waterford Road, and how the commercial wastes in the burn pit were generated. Also, there was a small pile of cans of solvents, paints, etc. sitting on the ground near the burn pile. Please describe how this waste was generated and how you plan to dispose of it.
