Dear Mr. Adams:

Thank you for your response received on December 14, 2011 to my November 30, 2011 Notice of Violation letter. My letter was sent as a result of a November 18 and 23, 2011 complaint investigation. In your letter, you explained that the 13191 Waterford Road address that I previously used for your rental home company, Kelcor Enterprises is the address of the previous owner of Kelcor Enterprises. You also explained that the 525 Eighth Street, Marietta address, where 40 plastic containers labeled "U-47 Bond Coat" were observed by me, is the address of a rental property owned by your company. During a telephone call with you on December 22, 2011, you provided me with the phone number of your tenant, Cathy Van Fossen, whose boyfriend, Frank, was responsible for the containers.

I spoke with Frank on December 22, 2011, after I had observed on December 13, 2011 that the containers had been removed from the Eighth Street property. Frank stated that the containers had been empty buckets of asphalt coating generated at his workplace, Triplett's Asphalt and Maintenance, in West Virginia. He had taken the empty containers home, filled them with water to determine if they were watertight, and had intended to use them for trout lines. Last week, he emptied the water onto the ground, took the empty containers to his brother's residence in Barlow, and burned them.

Based on MSDS information for U-47 Bond Coat indicating that this material is not a hazardous waste, and the fact that the containers were empty, the violation cited in Ohio EPA's November 30, 2011 letter has now been abated. I also informed Frank that burning of the empty plastic buckets, which are a solid waste, is illegal. Solid waste must be sent to a licensed solid waste landfill.
