Subject: Rescinded violation letter issued November 15, 2011

On November 15, 2011, I sent you a letter for failure to conduct required repeat total coliform monitoring for the third quarter of 2011.

Please note we have received the required repeat sample results that were collected on October 3, 2011. Therefore, the monitoring violation noticed above is rescinded.

By way of explanation, the laboratory sent the results in a timely manner, but they submitted two samples with a collection date of October 3<sup>rd</sup> and two samples with a collection date of October 4<sup>th</sup>. Since our records showed that all four samples were not collected on the sample day, a violation letter was issued. Upon receipt of your copies of the sample results showing all four repeat samples were collected on October 3<sup>rd</sup>, we have corrected our records.
