Thank you for your January 5, 2012 letter regarding my December 9, 2011 inspection of Karder Machine located at 258 Kenmore Boulevard in Akron, Ohio. As outlined below, your letter documents the correction of all the violations found during that inspection.

1. **OAC Rule 3745-52-11 – Hazardous waste determination.**

Your letter states water and used gear oil were the contents of all the barrels. This documents your correction of this violation.

2. **OAC Rule 3745-279-22(B) – Condition of used oil storage units.**

3. **OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C) – Used oil labels.**

You provided documentation of the shipment of all the used oil and water to Akron-Canton Waste Oil which documents your correction of these two violations.

4. **OAC Rule 3745-279-22(D) - Response to releases of used oil.**

In your letter and during our January 6, 2012 phone call, you stated that all used oil contaminated soil was removed and disposed of as solid waste with Republic Services.
