Dear Mr. Rudolph:

I have received your November 21, 2011 fax which responded to the violation and concerns I found during my August 10, 2011 inspection of Excalibur Auto Body located at 30520 Lakeland Boulevard, Willowick, Ohio. Your fax included a manifest for the September 2, 2011 shipment of 1000 pounds of hazardous waste paint related materials to Safety-Kleen in Smithfield, Kentucky. I encourage you to keep track of how much hazardous waste is generated during each month so that you know which generator category you fall into. A Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator is less than 220 pounds per calendar month. A Small Quantity Generator is 220 to 2200 pounds per calendar month. You have documented a correction of the violation and concerns found during my inspection.
