

Thank you for your December 21, 2011 email response to Ohio EPA's September 20, 2011 notice of violation letter.

You submitted photographs showing the broken fluorescent bulbs have been cleaned up, a copy of the proposal for Sun Pro to manage used fluorescent bulbs, and information that Mahoning Lighting company handbook is being updated and will include the proper way that employees will manage used fluorescent bulbs.

MLM has returned to compliance with the following violations noted during Ohio EPA's September 8, 2011 inspection:

1. **Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-52-11; evaluation of waste.**
2. **OAC 3745-273-13(D)(2) and OAC 3745-273-17(A); response and cleanup of broken bulbs.**
3. **OAC 3745-273-16; Employee training for Small Quantity handlers of Universal Waste.**

No response to this letter is required.
