This letter acknowledges receipt on December 20, 2011 and January 9, 2012 of your e-mail correspondence responding to Ohio EPA's Notice of Violation (NOV) letter dated December 7, 2011.

My review of the documentation provided by this correspondence, which included photographs of closed and labeled containers, inspection logs and emergency contact information, indicates that Meritec has adequately demonstrated abatement of the following violations from the November 8, 2011 inspection cited in my letter of December 7, 2011, specifically:

1. **OAC Rule 3745-66-73(A) Satellite Accumulation Containers Must Be Closed.**
2. **OAC Rule 3745-52-34(C)(1)(b) Labeling of Satellite Accumulation Containers.**
3. **OAC Rule 3745-66-74 Inspection Log.**
4. **OAC Rule 3745-65-33 Emergency Equipment Log.**
5. **OAC Rule 3745-52 34(D)(5)(b) Information must be posted next to the telephone.**
