Thank you for your December 16, 2011 (dated December 14, 2011) response to Ohio EPA's November 9, 2011 Notice of Violation letter. The documentation you submitted included the statement that Kraft Fluid Systems will be managing its used lamps as universal waste and recycling them through an approved lamp recycler (Safety-Kleen Systems) no less than once per year. As to your used oil, you indicated that Kraft Fluid Systems will be recycling this oil through Homan Oil Co.

My review of this documentation reveals that Kraft Fluid Systems has now abated all violations discovered during the October 28, 2011 inspection as listed below.
