Dear Mr. Coblentz:

On November 7, 2011, I spoke with you regarding the illegal open burning conducted on your property.

At that time, a verbal warning was issued and a copy of the Open Burning Regulations was furnished for your reference.

Please be advised that Chapter 3745-19 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) prohibits open burning for waste disposal purposes. Please find an alternative means of disposal.


Additionally, it was discovered that you are operating processes that may be regulated by the Ohio Revised Code (ORC), Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), and Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) without air pollution permits. You indicated that you are currently completing permit applications.

After speaking with your consultant, Mr. Robert Jarrett, it has been determined that there are many processes requiring permitting, and an extended time is required to finish the applications. Please submit the appropriate permit applications **within 45 days of receipt of this letter**.

The submission of the requested information does not constitute a waiver of Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in ORC 3704.06. Ohio EPA will decide whether to pursue or decline to pursue penalties regarding this matter at a later date.
