### WARNING LETTER

Dear Mrs. Cason:

On November 23, 2011, the Regional Air Pollution Control Agency (RAPCA) received a citizen complaint concerning the open burning of trash at 48/50 Irwin Dr., Dayton, Ohio. It was discovered that the Dayton Fire Department responded to this residence on at least two occasions (03/15/2011 and 07/19/2011) and verified that the burning of trash was occurring.

The open burning of trash for waste disposal is prohibited in the State of Ohio and is a violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) and Montgomery County Combined General Health District Air Pollution Control Regulations (MCCGHDAPCR) 3745-19-03 "Open Burning in a Restricted Area". A restricted area is an area within the boundary of any municipal corporation, plus a zone extending one mile beyond any such municipal corporation.

This letter serves as a warning from the Regional Air Pollution Control Agency to cease all open burning in violation of both state and local air pollution control regulations. In the future, alternative means of disposal must be employed.

**Any further violations of the above referenced rules may result in enforcement action which may include criminal and /or civil penalties.**
