**Subject: Failure to Monitor Drinking Water**

Wauseon City Water is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code Rule (OAC) 3745-81-24 for failing to monitor your drinking water during the April, May and June, 2011 monitoring periods and/or report results for the following contaminants: SIMAZINE, ATRAZINE, ALACHLOR (LASSO). Results have been received for a drinking water sample collected on July 12, 2011.

**In order to return to compliance**, Wauseon City Water must take the following actions:

1. Notify your customers using the enclosed instructions and public notice.
2. Complete and return the enclosed verification form to this office.

# DRINKING WATER NOTICE

## Monitoring requirements not met for Wauseon City Water

*We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the April, May and June, 2011 time periods we did not monitor for the following contaminants and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time: SIMAZINE, ATRAZINE and ALACHLOR.*

### What Should I Do?

This notice is to inform you that Wauseon City Water did not monitor and report results for the presence of the contaminants listed above in the public drinking water system as required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency. You do not need to take any actions in response to this notice.

### What Is Being Done?

Upon being notified of this violation, the water supply was required to have the drinking water analyzed for the above mentioned parameters. The water supplier will take steps to ensure that adequate monitoring will be performed in the future.
