Dear Mr. Jabbar:

On January 18, 2012, I performed a hazardous waste inspection of your store to determine its compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws and regulations as found in Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

Based on the observations and documentation reviewed during the investigation, Ohio EPA issued a Notice of Violation to you on January 25, 2012. I spoke with you on January 27, 2012 and understand that you will now begin collecting spent bulbs and manage in accordance with the universal waste rules until your contractor Petro-Com collects them for recycling, therefore you have returned to compliance with the following hazardous waste regulation:

(1)OAC rule 3745-52-11, Hazardous waste determination.

You have abated all violations cited during the January 18, 2012 inspection.
