Thank you for your November 15, 2011, response letter to Ohio EPA's November 1, 2011, Notice of Violation letter. Ohio Valley Outdoors' timely communication and actions to return to compliance are appreciated. You provided evidence of corrections related to:

Waste Evaluation OAC rule 3745-52-11: The floor sweepings are now being managed as D008 hazardous waste, and waste fluorescent lamp tubes and HID bulbs are being managed as universal waste (for recycling).

My review shows you have adequately abated the violation discovered during the October 12 and 17, 2011, inspection visits at your facility. Please be advised that if your business' monthly hazardous waste generation exceeds 220 lbs. then it would be a Small Quantity Generator with additional specific requirements including generator notification to Ohio EPA, accumulation time limits, container labeling and marking, emergency procedures, etc. I would be happy to discuss those with you in more detail if needed.
