NOTICE OF VIOLATION - ACTION REQUIRED

Subject: Failure to Monitor Drinking Water

Buckeye Lake Truck Stop is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-81-23 for failing to monitor your drinking water during the April 1, 2008 to June 30, 2008 monitoring period and/or report results for the following contaminants: ARSENIC

In order to return to compliance, Buckeye Lake Truck Stop must take the following actions:

1. Immediately collect a sample of your drinking water from the entry point (first tap after treatment).
2. Submit the sample for analysis to a certified laboratory on the enclosed list.
3. Notify your customers using the enclosed instructions and public notice.
4. Complete and return the enclosed verification form to this office.

Your prompt attention to this matter is greatly appreciated. Continued noncompliance may lead to enforcement actions. If you have any questions or if the required sample was tested, please call me at (614) 644-2752.

DRINKING WATER NOTICE

Monitoring requirements not met for Buckeye Lake Truck Stop

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the April 1, 2008 to June 30, 2008 time period we did not monitor for the following contaminants and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time: ARSENIC.

What Should I Do?

This notice is to inform you that Buckeye Lake Truck Stop did not monitor and report results for the presence of the contaminants listed above in the public drinking water system during the April 1, 2008 to June 30, 2008 time period, as required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency. You do not need to take any actions in response to this notice.

What Is Being Done?

Upon being notified of this violation, the water supply was required to have the drinking water analyzed for the above mentioned parameters. The water supplier will take steps to ensure that adequate monitoring will be performed in the future.
