Notice of Violation

Re: Failure to demonstrate permitted particulate emissions limit for emissions unit P020, Small Mill Flapping Unit (aka Galatin Mill).

Dear Mr. Poldoka,

The December 2007, stack test results, as reported in the February 8, 2008 stack test report for emissions unit P020, indicated an average PM emissions rate of 0.14 lb/hr. The PM emission limitations of 0.06 lb/hr for this emissions unit was established in permit-to-install (PTI) 05-3397, issued in September 1989. This emission rate exceeds the maximum allowable as established in the PTI. This is the second failed stack test for this emissions unit. The first failure resulted in a warning letter issued by Ohio EPA on July 12, 2007.

In order to assure quick response to this failure and assure that the emissions from Daido Metals Bellefontaine, are minimized, please submit the following information to this office:

- A compliance plan and schedule for achieving and maintaining compliance.



The Ohio EPA reserves the right, pursuant to Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, 3745, and 3750 of the Ohio Revised Code and any other applicable state or federal laws or regulations to seek civil and/or criminal action, reimbursement of response costs and any other appropriate legal or equitable relief for any violation of law.
