**Subject: Failure to Sample Drinking Water for Total Coliforms as Required**

Ashley Village PWS is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), Rule 3745-81-21 for failure to comply with the total coliform monitoring.

<b>Monitoring Period:</b>	May 2011
<b>Required Coliform Monitoring:</b>	2 routine per MN
<b>Sample Results Submitted:</b>	One

To ensure the safety of drinking water provided by your system monitoring for total coliforms is essential.

**ACTION REQUIRED:**

1. **Notify the people served by this water system** using one or more of the methods and the timing as required by OAC, Rule 3745-81-32 to reach all persons served.

**Timing:** As soon as practical, but no later than one year after learning of the violation:

- Mail or other direct delivery to each customer; OR
  - Annual Consumer Confidence Report provided it's distributed within one year after learning of the violation; and
  - If necessary to reach all persons regularly served, use other notification methods such as newspaper publication, public posting or Internet posting;
  - Posted notices must remain in place as long as the violation or situation exists, but in no case less than seven days (even if the violation is resolved). The language in italics on the enclosed public notice is mandatory and must be included, as written. Do not make changes to the public notice without consulting with the Ohio EPA beforehand.
2. **Complete the enclosed Verification Form within 10 days of issuing the Public Notice** and mail it to Ohio EPA - CDO. Include a copy of each notice distributed, published or posted.


