Your public water system is in violation of Rule 3745-81-21 of the Ohio Administrative Code for failure to comply with the coliform monitoring requirements:

<b>Monitoring Period:</b>	February 2007
<b>Required Coliform Sampling:</b>	At least 15 samples each month.
<b>Sample Results Submitted:</b>	14

Actions required as a result of the above violation	
Step 1	<p>Within 30 days issue public notice of the violation in accordance with rule 3745-81-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code by the following methods:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Mail or other direct delivery to each customer receiving a bill and to other service connections; and</li> <li>2. If necessary, the system must also use any other method reasonably calculated to reach all persons.</li> </ol> <p>Note: Systems opting to include the required public notice in the next water bill have up to 90 days.</p> <p>The language in <i>italics</i> on the attached public notice is mandatory and must be included as written.</p>
Step 2	<p>Within ten (10) days of completing <b>Step 1</b> above, fill out the attached verification form and send along with a copy of the public notification issued to the District Office of the Ohio EPA.</p>
