

| Step 1 | Collect and analyze the required number of lead and copper tap samples during June 1 - September 30, 2008. Based upon the reported population, you are required to collect a minimum of 10 lead and copper samples. Report results on the enclosed forms 5105, 5106 and 5107 by October 10, 2008. |
| Step 2 | <p>Within 30 days issue public notice of the violation in accordance with rule 3745-81-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code by the following methods:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. mail or other direct delivery to each customer receiving a bill and to other service connections; and 2. if necessary, the system must also use any other method reasonably calculated to reach all persons. <p>Note: Systems opting to include the required public notice in the next water bill have up to 90 days.</p> <p>The language in <i>italics</i> on the attached public notice is mandatory and must be included as written.</p> |
