Dear Mr. Rogala:

On January 16, 2007, the Ohio EPA's Division of Hazardous Waste Management (DHWM) received your response to the compliance evaluation inspection (CEI) conducted November 30, 2006. The response included information on the following: waste evaluation, personnel training, contingency plan documentation, closed containers, labeling and marking of universal waste. Your response also provided information relative to aerosol cans, used oil and rags.

Based on review of the response submitted, Ohio EPA has determined that the Pechiney Plastic Packaging, Inc. facility appears to have abated all violations identified in the December 13, 2006 Notice of Violation letter.

**CONCERNS, RECOMMENDATIONS, COMMENTS**

Ohio EPA has the following comments and requires a response where indicated:

- Provide a copy of the sample data from analysis of the film analyzed for violation #1. It is understood that all film is now being retained and sent for recycle.
- A program has been set up to insure compliance with the empty container requirements for aerosol cans and other small containers. Empty cans may be recycled with other scrap metal.
- Listed solvent contaminated rags from a RCRA waste cleanup must be disposed as a hazardous waste or sent to be laundered.
