Dear Mr. Cline:

This office received your written response to the September 7, 2007, Notice of Violation which that was issued to the Village of South Bloomfield. Your response did not sufficiently address some of the requirements and additional information is needed.

1. To verify the flow rates of the metering pumps, a calibration column needs to be installed in the suction line of the chemical feed pumps. Submit the results along with the specifications of the Stenner pumps.
2. Submit the raw water quality data for iron and manganese concentrations from both wells. The analysis must have been performed by a certified laboratory.
3. Submit the well pump output data for each well.
4. Submit the sieve analysis data on the filter media that was installed earlier this year.
5. The certified operator contract is not approvable as written. OAC 3745-7-03 (A)(2), states that your water system shall maintain the same level of classification and staffing that it has always had unless a substantial change to the public water system is approved in accordance with Chapter 3745-91 of the Administrative Code or until July 1, 2009. This requires you to hire a Class I operator who is at the plant five days a week. The duties and time allotment of the operator needs to be defined in the contract.


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In addition to providing the required information, this office is requesting a meeting with South Bloomfield public water system officials to discuss the actions necessary to return this system to compliance. This meeting is only intended to establish dialog between Ohio EPA and the Village of South Bloomfield to provide an opportunity to answer any questions you may have and to ensure that requirements are addressed in a manner to ensure compliance. Per your request to meet on a Tuesday, I have scheduled the meeting for October 9, 2007, at 10:00 a.m., at the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency Central District Office.

Continued noncompliance may result in additional enforcement action. If an enforcement action is necessary, potential consequences may include penalties and loss of licensures. Ohio EPA is authorized under Revised Code chapter 6109.33 to assess penalties up to **\$25,000.00 per day per violation**. We are providing this information as an opportunity to return to compliance before these actions are necessary.

I am requesting that you contact me at (614) 728-3870 within the next five business days to confirm the date and location of the meeting. Also, please feel free to contact me with any questions you may have concerning this request.
