**Re: Notice of Violation for Operational Requirements & Operator Certification Rule**

Dear Mr. Croston:

In accordance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-83-01(I)(2), public water systems are required to submit monthly operational reports (MORs) to Ohio EPA Division of Drinking and Ground Waters by the tenth of the month following the reporting month. This report is **required to be signed** by an Operator of Record for the water system. Wagon Wheel MHP is in violation of OAC 3745-83-01, because the September MOR was signed by you and you do not possess an operator's license.

Ohio EPA has sent correspondence dated April 9, 2008, September 3, 2008, and September 25, 2008, informing you to submit the *Operator of Record Notification* form to our office to comply with operator certification requirements in accordance with OAC 3745-7-02.

You are required to submit the *Operator of Record Notification* form immediately to Ohio EPA along with a copy of the signed contract between you and a certified operator. If you continue being noncompliant with these rules, your water system will be referred for enforcement.
