Dear Mr. Hayden:

Thank you for your July 25, 2011, and July 27, 2011, responses to Ohio EPA's July 19, 2011, Notice of Violation letter (NOV). On July 25, 2011, Mr. Harold Fitz of Transco Railway Products, Inc. (Transco) sent me an email stating that the coal pile samples were taken from the coal pile in Toledo. (There is no coal pile at the Bucyrus facility). I had mistakenly thought that there was also another coal pile at the Bucyrus facility – I apologize for the confusion. In addition, Mr. Fitz stated that in the future Transco rail cars and covered hoppers will be reviewed for last content and when possible the commodity will remain in the car. If the commodity requires disposal by Transco, then the waste will be evaluated via lab testing. In addition, on July 27, 2011, you submitted to me analytical information indicating that the waste coal from the coal pile at your Toledo facility is non-hazardous.


My review of this documentation reveals that Transco has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violation discovered during the June 28, 2011, inspection as listed below:
