Dear Mr. Scorziell:

Thank you for your August 22, 2011, response to my July 22, 2011, Notice of Violation letter. You submitted analytical for the paint booth filters.

The following is the status of the violations found during our inspection:

1. Waste Evaluation, OAC Rule 3745-52-11:

Any person who generates a waste must determine if that waste is a hazardous waste by using generator knowledge or by testing the waste.

At the time of the inspection, Tronair did not have waste evaluation documentation for the spent paint booth filters.

Ohio EPA received analytical results on August 22, 2011. These results indicated the paint booth filters are non-hazardous. Tronair can manage the filters as solid waste. Please know that if your process changes, you may need to re-evaluate your solvent waste/paint booth filters. Gun cleanout solvent/thinner must also not be sprayed onto the filter. Tronair will continue to be a conditionally exempt small quantity generator unless you generate (approximately) more than 25 gallons of hazardous waste per month.

2. Labeling of Used Oil, OAC 3745-279-22(C)(1):

On July 13, 2011, you submitted, via email, photographs of the drums properly labeled "Used Oil". *This violation was previously abated.*


3. Universal Waste Management, OAC Rule 3745-273-13(D)(1):

Tronair closed this box of lamps at the time of inspection, July 12, 2011. *This violation was previously abated.*

Tronair has adequately abated all violations cited during Ohio EPA's July 12, 2011, hazardous waste compliance evaluation inspection.
