Dear Mr. Gibson:

On April 19, 2010, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency received a complaint concerning property owned by you on Webb Heights Road in Belmont County. This complaint alleged the illegal disposal of demolition debris, primarily roofing shingles, on your property.

On April 21, 2010, I met with you at your property to discuss this complaint. You stated at this time that you had allowed approximately two loads of roofing shingles to be dumped on your property in the hopes of recycling the material at a later time.

You are in violation of Ohio Administrative Code Rule (OAC) 3745-400-04(B). All demolition debris must be removed for proper disposal.

OAC 3745-400-04(B) states in part:

OAC 3745-400-04(B) - No person shall conduct or allow illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris. . .

The demolition debris must be removed from the above-mentioned property and disposed of at either a licensed solid waste disposal facility. Copies of receipts should be submitted to this office for proof of disposal.

Please respond to this correspondence within 14 days of receipt. Your response should include details of your actions taken to properly dispose or recycle the current waste on your property.

Also during this visit, you stated that the local township brings leaves to your property in order to compost this material. If you continue to compost leaves on your property, other than leaves generated on your property, you will need to be registered as a Class IV composting facility. Please find enclosed composting facility registration forms. Please fill

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the necessary information and forward these forms to Ohio EPA Central Office for processing.
