Dear Mr. Gibson:

On April 19, 2010, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency received a complaint concerning property owned by you on Webb Heights Road in Belmont County. This complaint alleged the illegal disposal of demolition debris, primarily roofing shingles, on your property.

On May 28, 2010, I conducted a reinspection. You were not on site at the time of this visit. The shingles were still present.

You remain in violation of Ohio Administrative Code Rule (OAC) 3745-400-04(B). All demolition debris must be removed for proper disposal.

OAC 3745-400-04(B) states in part:

OAC 3745-400-04(B) - No person shall conduct or allow illegal disposal of construction and demolition debris. . .

The demolition debris must be removed from the above-mentioned property and disposed of at either a licensed solid waste disposal facility. Copies of receipts should be submitted to this office for proof of disposal.

Please respond to this correspondence within 14 days of receipt. Your response should include details of your actions taken to properly dispose or recycle the current waste on your property.
