Step 2	<p>Within ten (10) days of completing Step 1 above, fill out the attached verification form and send along with a copy of the public notification issued to the Southeast District Office of the Ohio EPA.</p>

DRINKING WATER NOTICE

Monitoring requirements not met for the SOMERDALE INN

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. During July 2007, we did not complete all monitoring or testing for total coliform bacteria, and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

What Should I Do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. You do not need to boil your water or take other corrective action.

This notice is to inform you that the SOMERDALE INN did not monitor and report results for the presence of total coliform bacteria in the public drinking water system during the July 2007 time period, as required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency.
