Subject: Notice of Violation of Maximum Contaminant Level for Total Coliform Bacteria (ACUTE & Failure to Monitor with four repeat samples and five routines)

During February 2007, your public water system incurred an **acute** violation of rule 3745-81-14 (D) of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) and a **monitoring** violation of rule 3745-81-21 (B)(1) of the OAC for failure to collect four (4) repeat samples within the required time period and your failure to collect five samples in the month following a positive result.

Actions required as a result of the above violation	
Step 1	<p>Within 24 hours, consult with Ohio EPA and issue the attached public notice in accordance with rule 3745-81-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code using the following methods to reach all persons served by the public water system:</p> <p>1. posting in conspicuous locations (restrooms, drinking fountains, vending areas, restaurants, bulletin boards, etc.)</p> <p>The language in italics on the attached public notice is mandatory and must be included as written.</p>
Step 2	If not already done, Immediately initiate an investigation to determine and eliminate the cause and extent of bacterial contamination.
Step 3	Fill out the attached verification form and send along with a copy of the public notification issued, to the Southeast District Office of the Ohio EPA.
Step 4	Lifting the Advisory - The public notice water use advisory shall remain in effect until you obtain one complete set of four (4) total coliform-negative (contain no coliforms) repeat samples. These samples were collected 2-8-07.
Step 5	Because you are required to monitor with at least five (5) samples in the next month following any total coliform-positive result you were to take at least five (5) total coliform samples in February 2007.

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Please note, although the rule requires you to collect four repeat samples within 24 hours of your receiving the results of the positive sample, we allow up to 14 days. Your four samples were collected on the 15th day and you failed to collect five samples in the month following the positive result.

Please be advised: While you may have previously been allowed to count four repeat samples taken the following month toward your 5, that practice will be dis-allowed in the future. Ohio EPA will soon require five routine samples to be taken the month following a positive sample to comply with federal requirements and revised Ohio rules. DRINKING WATER NOTICE

Monitoring requirements not met for the Tatmans Restaurant PWS

Sampling conducted for our water system showed total coliform bacteria were found in a sample collected in **January 2007**. We were required to collect four repeat samples within 24 hours of notification of any total coliform positive result to determine if *E. coli* or fecal coliform bacteria were present. These bacteria can make you sick, and are a particular concern for people with weakened immune systems. Although repeat sampling was not conducted in the required time period specified, additional sampling has now been conducted and indicates that the water does not pose an acute risk to human health.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. You do not need to boil your water or take other corrective action.

This notice is to inform you that the Tatmans Restaurant PWS did not monitor and report results for the presence of total coliform bacteria in the public drinking water system during the February 2007 time period, as required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency.

What is being done?

Upon being notified of this violation, the water supply was required to have the drinking water analyzed for the above mentioned parameters. The water supplier will take steps to ensure that adequate monitoring will be performed in the future.
