Subject: Failure to Monitor Drinking Water

Englewood Manor Apts. is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code Rule (OAC) 3745-81-26 for failing to monitor your drinking water during the July 1 to September 30, 2010 monitoring period and/or report results for the following contaminants: Radium-226 and Radium-228.

A report has since been received for a drinking water sample collected on October 20, 2010 and analyzed for Radium-226 and Radium-228.

In order to return to compliance, Englewood Manor Apts. must take the following actions:

1. Notify your customers using the enclosed instructions and public notice.
2. Complete and return the enclosed verification form to this office.

DRINKING WATER NOTICE

Monitoring requirements not met for Englewood Manor Apts.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the July 1 to September 30, 2010 time period we did not monitor for the following contaminants and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time: RADIUM-226 and RADIUM-228.

What Should I Do?

This notice is to inform you that Englewood Manor Apts. did not monitor and report results for the presence of the contaminants listed above in the public drinking water system during the July 1 to September 30, 2010 time period, as required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency. You do not need to take any actions in response to this notice.

What Is Being Done?

Upon being notified of this violation, the water supply was required to have the drinking water analyzed for the above mentioned parameters. The water supplier will take steps to ensure that adequate monitoring will be performed in the future.


