Ohio EPA is in receipt of Chrome Deposit Corporation's March 20, 2007 letter responding to Ohio EPA's February 22, 2007 Notice of Violation (NOV) letter. Your response includes two slides from the personnel training plan and a record documenting that personnel training has occurred.

My review of your response reveals that Chrome Deposit has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violation and general concern noted in Ohio EPA's February 22, 2007 Notice of Violation. Prior to conducting further personnel training, please review the personnel training requirements found in OAC 3745-65-16 and continue to develop your personnel training program to ensure it complies with all parts of this rule. One notable requirement is that the training program must be designed to ensure that facility personnel are able to respond effectively to emergencies by familiarizing them with emergency procedures, emergency equipment, and emergency systems.
