This letter acknowledges receipt, on February 3, 2012, of your correspondence dated February 2, 2012, responding to Ohio EPA's Notice of Violation (NOV) letter dated November 12, 2010 and a Second NOV letter dated August 18, 2011.

My review of the documentation provided by this correspondence, which includes the facility's Universal Waste Policy and Program and an attendance log for universal waste training, indicates that the Youngstown Waste Water Treatment Plant has adequately demonstrated abatement of the following violations from the November 3, 2010 inspection cited in my letters of November 12, 2010 and August 18, 2011, specifically:

1. **OAC Rule 3745-52-11 Waste Evaluation**
2. **OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C)(1) Used oil containers must be labelled with the words "Used Oil"**
3. **OAC Rule 3745-273-16 Employee training for small quantity handlers of universal waste**
