Dear Mr. Voisard,

The NPDES permit for the above facility includes a Schedule of Compliance. According to the Schedule of Compliance Part I, C- Schedule of Compliance, Number 2, The permittee shall implement measures identified in the evaluation that can reasonably be expected to maximize the ability of the existing treatment facilities to achieve a final effluent limit of 1.0 mg/l total phosphorus by **July 1, 2007**. This office to date has not received this from this facility.

Also, Ohio EPA has reviewed your Monthly Operating Reports (MORs) covering the months of December 2006 through May 2007 for the referenced facility. Our review indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES Permit (NPDES Permit # OH0020656; OEPA Permit # 1PB00033*FD). The specific instances of noncompliance and/or deficiencies were as follows:

“Semi-annual (2/Year) sampling frequency”-means the sampling shall be done during the months of June and December, unless specifically identified otherwise.



Your response should include the dates, either actual or proposed, for completion of the actions. Future violations must be reported as required by the NPDES Permit as detailed in Part III.12 titled "Noncompliance Notification."
