Dear Mr. Bruewer :

I have performed a compliance review under your NPDES permit for the review period of January 2009 through October 2010. My review shows that there were some reporting violations for failure to take color, odor, and turbidity readings in March 2009 and data not collected for July 2009 and August 2010.

I have also reviewed your self-monitoring reports for the months of January 2009 through October 2010, for the discharge outfall 001 from the wastewater treatment system. The review indicates the following effluent limit violations of the NPDES permit for this facility.

EFFLUENT LIMIT VIOLATIONS AT OUTFALL 001

Our office received non-compliance notifications from National Wastewater Industries for these effluent limit violations and reporting violations. Mitigative data was collected in September 2010 for the missed sampling in the prior month. No response is required for this Notice of Violation.

Please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limitations or to satisfy the monitoring or reporting requirements of your NPDES permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.
