We have reviewed your Monthly Operating Reports (MORs) covering the months of May through September 2007 for the referenced facility. Our review indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES Permit (NPDES Permit # OH0047287; OEPA Permit # 1PT00050*ED). The specific instances of noncompliance and deficiencies were as follows:

We have reviewed your reports addressing the reasons for the August 2007 violations and the actions being taken to prevent further occurrences. However, the July and September 2007 violations have not been addressed. Please inform this office, in writing, within ten days of receipt of this notification as to the reasons for the July and September violations,



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as well as a description of the actions taken or proposed to prevent any further violations. Your response should include the dates, either actual or proposed, for completion of the actions. Future violations must be reported as required by the NPDES Permit as detailed in Part III.12 titled "Noncompliance Notification."
