The Ohio EPA has completed a compliance evaluation of the Monthly Operating Reports covering the months of September 2009 through June 2010 for the Diamond Oaks Career Development Center. The evaluation indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES Permit (NPDES Permit # OH0047287; OEPA Permit # 1PT00050*ED). The specific instances of noncompliance are as follows:

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

The Ohio EPA has received a response for all the violations which occurred in August and September of 2009. The Ohio EPA also received a response for the Dissolved Oxygen violations which occurred on November 11, 18 and December 3 of 2009. Your response to the balance of the violations listed above should include the dates, either actual or proposed, for completion of said actions.
