We have reviewed your report addressing the reasons for the effluent limit violation and the actions being taken to prevent further occurrences. No additional information regarding this violation is required at this time.



Please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limitations, monitoring, or reporting requirements of your NPDES Permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.
