Dear Mr. and Mrs. Childress:

On July 20, 2010, I inspected the wastewater treatment system at Edgewater Mobile Home Park. A copy of my inspection report is attached along with a list of violations of your NPDES permit.

You are without a Class I operator of record at your facility. You have expressed a desire to become certified as a Class A operator. I've attached some information regarding how to become an operator and the 2010 exam dates. You will also need to apply for a permit modification to change the rating of your facility to a Class A.

You had a question about the number of mobile home units that were part of the design of the treatment plant. The Permit to Install approval from Ohio EPA for the treatment plant was for 28 mobile homes. Any expansion to add additional mobile homes will have to be reviewed by Ohio EPA and the health department.

If you need further compliance assistance with the operation of your treatment plant, you may contact Victor Reverendo at (614) 728-2532.

Failure to comply with the conditions of your NPDES Permit may be cause for enforcement action. You are requested to respond to this letter within 10 days to discuss the actions that will be taken to come into compliance with your permit.
