Dear Mr. Blanchard:

This office has received the non-compliance notification for the above referenced facility. Our review indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES permit. The specific instances of non-compliance and/or deficiencies were as follows:

Station No. 1IN00075008

A spill was reported to Ohio EPA on April 23, 2007 as required in the facility's NPDES permit. The spill consisted of an estimated one gallon of a milky-white discharge extending 50 to 75 yards downstream of the outfall. The discharge was noticed on April 23, 2007 at 12:00 pm. The valve to the storm sewer was closed immediately. The release to Mill Creek was stopped at approximately 12:30 pm. Phone notification was made to Ohio EPA at 4:45 pm.

The cause of the discharge discoloration was found to be less than one gallon of Neodol AE 1.8 (alcohol ethoxylate) which entered the storm sewer. The spill was a result of a pressure related process upset which occurred inside the process building during an alcohol ethoxylate washout. The spilled material exited the building through an elevated double access door and entered an adjacent storm sewer.

Please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limitations, or to satisfy monitoring or reporting requirements of your NPDES permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.

This office has received written notification as the reasons for the above referenced violation, as well as the actions taken or proposed to prevent any further violations.
