

Self-Monitoring Report Notice of Violation- January 2007 through June 2007**

Dear Mr. Emerson Babington:

The NPDES permit for the above facility includes a Schedule of Compliance. The Schedule of Compliance requires the permittee uses chlorine for disinfection, the chlorine residual limitation shall be maintained at a level not to exceed 0.019 mg/l for the wastewater improvements by **January 1, 2007**. This office to date has not received a PTI application for this facility.

Also, we have reviewed your Monthly Operating Reports (MORs) covering the months of January 2007 through June 2007 for the referenced facility. Our review indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES Permit (NPDES Permit # OH0112569; OEPA Permit # 1PV00087*BD). The specific instances of noncompliance and/or deficiencies were as follows:
