We have reviewed your Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR) covering the month of January 2009 for the referenced facility. Our review indicates violations of the conditions of your NPDES Permit (NPDES Permit # OH0009156; OEPA Permit # 11C00003\*DD). The specific instances of noncompliance were as follows:


Finally, please be advised that failure to comply with the effluent limitations or to satisfy the reporting requirements of your NPDES Permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.

Please inform this office, in writing, within ten days of receipt of this notification as to the reasons for the above referenced violations, as well as a description of the actions taken or proposed to prevent any further violations. Your response should include the dates, either actual or proposed, for completion of the actions. Future violations must be reported as required by the NPDES Permit as detailed in Part III.12 titled "Noncompliance Notification." NPDES Permit violations may also be reported in accordance to the new Ohio EPA reporting requirements.
